Montréal, May 23, 2024 – The One Drop Foundation is proud of the success of *A Swing for One Drop*, organized in an unprecedented collaboration between Cirque du Soleil Entertainment Group and the Presidents Cup. The event raised an exceptional sum of over \$500,000.

Organized as part of the Montréal premiere of Cirque du Soleil's *KURIOS-Cabinet of Curiosities* show in the historic Old Port on May 23, the event attracted over 200 guests who united for a prestigious benefit event preceding the show.

In addition to the evening's proceeds, the Presidents Cup presented the One Drop Foundation with a donation of \$250,000. One Drop was chosen as one of the charitable beneficiaries ahead of the upcoming tournament to be held at The Royal Montreal Golf Club in September.
